Are you eligible* for our services?

Age pensioners, veterans, Indigenous Australians aged over 50, children and young adults aged under 21 are entitled to subsidised hearing services from Australian Hearing.

Visit any one of our 110 centres to get advice on your hearing. Our services include consultations, hearing checks, rehabilitation programs, hearing device fittings, batteries and repairs.

Batteries, service and maintenance for your hearing devices

Ensuring your devices are well maintained and you have a regular supply of batteries is all part of the excellent benefits you receive through your Hearing Services Card. Our maintenance services include mechanical and electrical repairs, ear mould and shell renewal and repair, cord replacement and microphone replacement. We can also clean your hearing device and make sure it's delivering the best sound for your needs.

The card is available at our centres for a small annual fee.

* Eligible people¹ are entitled to fully or partially subsidised hearing devices depending on their clinical needs under the Australian Government Hearing Services Program. ¹To be eligible to receive services under this program, a person must be: an Australian pensioner concession cardholder or their dependant; a Department of Veterans' Affairs gold or white repatriation cardholder (specifically for war-related hearing loss) or their dependant; a sickness allowance recipient or their dependant; a referred client of an Australian Government funded vocational rehabilitation service; a member of the Australian Defence Forces; an Australian citizen or permanent resident under 21 years of age; an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person aged over 50 years, or who is a current participant of a Community Development Employment Project, or who was participating in this program between 1 December 2005 and 30 June 2008.
