1 Cultural Determinants of Health

Explain the cultural determinants of health and the impacts on ear disease and hearing loss.

3 Prevention and Service Modifications

Modify the learning environment to support ear health and improve hearing, listening and communication.

- Implement prevention techniques into your ECEC and daily practice.

- Implement hearing and listening friendly communication strategies in the early learning environment.

2 Understanding Ear Health and Hearing

- Explain otitis media, hearing loss, conductive hearing loss and its causes.
- Recognise how ear disease and hearing loss impact a child's learning, behaviour, and educational outcomes.

4 Screening Tools

Identify possible listening and communication difficulties in children using PLUM and HATS in partnership with families.

- Understand the purpose of using PLUM and HATS and relay this to families.
- Have a conversation with families about a child's listening and communication behaviour using the PLUM and HATS screening tools.
- Score and interpret the PLUM and HATS results.
