Hearing support if you're unemployed

Are you struggling to hear in everyday situations? You may qualify for fully subsidised hearing help if you're:

- Aged 26 to 66 years, currently unemployed and hold a valid Health Care Card;*
- Experiencing hearing difficulties and believe hearing aids could help; and
- Not covered by the Australian Government's Hearing Services Program (HSP) or National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).

Why getting hearing support matters

Hearing loss can make it harder to find and keep a job and may lead to social isolation. Improving your hearing can boost confidence, support better communication, and help you reconnect with work, family and your community.
